Evaluation Criteria

1. Pertinence to the conference theme and track titles.
2. Content: The presentation provides attendees with information and inspiration that will serve them professionally. As the conference is geared toward attendees with a high level of knowledge, presenters will be selected based on the innovation, rigor, and timeliness of the proposed topic. Your presentation is more likely to be selected if your content is focused, in-depth, and offers practical solutions, ideas, strategies, and / or techniques.
3. Relevance to session track themes and the conference's regional focus.
4. Diversity: The East Coast Green conference is geared towards a broad cross-section of the design and construction industry. Panels will be selected, in part, according to their contribution to the diversity of the Symposium's overall educational offerings.
5. Presentation Quality: The presenter must be an experienced communicator with the skills to deliver his or her presentation successfully.
6. Submittals must be complete in order to be considered. If two speakers submit for an 80 minute session both must complete separate submittals, cross referencing their partner where indicated.

Please note that not all proposals will be accepted. Speakers will be chosen at the sole discretion of the East Coast Green Executive Committee.
