AIA New Jersey Michael Graves Lifetime Achievement Award 2010

The AIA New Jersey Michael Graves Lifetime Achievement Award is the highest honor that AIA New Jersey may bestow on an individual. It is in recognition of a significant body of work of lasting influence on the theory and practice of architecture.

Criteria for Eligibility

Candidates will be evaluated on how well they meet the selection criteria which include:

- The candidate shall have evidenced great depth, having a cumulative effect on the profession of architecture and society in general.
- The candidate shall have evidenced great breadth, having influenced the direction of the profession of architecture and the built environment.
- The candidate shall be an individual whose contributions to the profession of architecture have consistently been directed toward the future as well as respectful of the past.
- The candidate shall have evidenced the ability to transcend specific areas of expertise or shall have made connections between areas, in the event that the candidate's areas of focus might be considered circumscribed.
- The candidate shall be widely known by the quality of his or her products: by those who practice architecture, by those who teach architecture, and by those who perhaps do neither.
- The candidate shall have been a member of AIA New Jersey in good standing and has strongly influenced and encouraged interns to pursue licensure.

Nomination Process Summary Sheet

Submissions

All exhibits must be submitted electronically in one single .PDF file not to exceed 6 MB for presentation to the MGLAA Committee and Jury.

- A nomination letter summarizing the nominee's contributions **not to exceed one page** from a member of the AIA New Jersey Board of Directors, a representative from an AIANJ component or from one AIA member sponsoring the nomination by petition.
- A brief biography of the nominee not to exceed three pages
- A statement /list of the nominee's achievements/awards not to exceed **ten** pages
- Descriptive exhibits of the nominee's work. No more than 10 exhibits with each exhibit not to exceed 3 pages. Architectural work should include site plan and interior photographs in addition to plan, elevation section and exterior photographs when possible.
- A maximum of up to 5 letters of support(not to exceed one page each)
- Optional-** miscellaneous material including clippings, articles etc. not to exceed three pages

Single .PDF file submitted on disk but separate file from above mentioned items:

- A completed Nomination Sheet
- If nomination is made by petition, completed Nomination Petition with signatures, printed names and AIA member numbers of 5 Fellow or 10 AIA members in good standing (none of whom are employed by the nominee's firm)
- Completed Release Forms
- A signed Intern Statement
- A black and white digital image of the candidate
