Tim graduated from Pittsburg State University with a Bachelors Degree in Construction Technology and Management. He is a certified Building Official and currently holds 15 separate certifications with ICC. Tim has served on the ICC Board of Directors since 1999. He also served on the BOCA Board of Directors for 10 years, including a term as the 54th President of that organization. He has served on numerous code development, technical ad-hoc, administrative and specialized committees for both the legacy code groups and for ICC. He is a seasoned instructor and speaker on a wide range of topics including Existing Buildings, Legal Aspects, Means of Egress and Accessibility.
